

Witzenmann opens first climate-neutral building in Zwickau

A prime example of sustainable growth: Witzenmann's new state-of-the-art administration building in Saxony. The Group's first climate-neutral building was officially opened in Zwickau last Monday, following the ground-breaking ceremony in April 2024, and is proof of the importance of the location for the Witzenmann Group.

After a construction period of just seven months, Witzenmann celebrated the opening of its new administration building in Zwickau, Saxony, on 4 November. The world's leading expert in the safe and efficient transmission of media and energy for mobility and industry is thus sending a clear signal that it is strengthening the location. "After modernising the production – the production hall and machines – we have invested over six million euros in the future of the region with the construction of the new administration building, thus underlining our confidence in the location and the skills of the employees here at the Zwickau plant," emphasised Frank Schmitt, managing director of Witzenmann in Saxony. With 82 employees, Zwickau is the group-wide lead plant and central competence centre for pipe supports and laser parts for industrial project business. The highly specialised products are used in large process engineering plants and are essential for the stability and safety of piping systems that weigh several tonnes.

Sustainable architecture sets standards

The new building is now considered the first climate-neutral building of the globally operating group of companies and is a milestone in the field of sustainability. "With this climate-neutral new building, we are setting an example in the region in terms of innovation and sustainability," says Frank Schmitt, managing director of Witzenmann in Saxony.



Modernity and functionality on 1,050 square metres

In addition to its sustainable design, the new administration building impresses with innovative room concepts. Its 1,050 square metres, spread over two floors, offer modern and flexible workplaces, a self-catering canteen, and spacious meeting rooms that promote creativity and collaboration. The integration of social areas for more than 50 employees from production emphasises the importance of close networking and further development of the Zwickau team, which makes a valuable contribution to the competitiveness of the group with its expertise in the field of pipe supports.

The inauguration ceremony was attended by representatives of the executing trades, Zwickau's Deputy Mayor for Construction, Silvia Queck-Hänel, as well as other regional representatives from the press, business and politics.
