

Prof. Manfred Broy takes over as Chairman of the Witzenmann Supervisory Board

On 11 June 2024, Prof. Dr Dr h.c. Manfred Broy was elected Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Witzenmann GmbH. He succeeds Prof Dr Herbert Paschen, who has been a member of the Witzenmann Supervisory Board since 1969, has been Chairman since 2013 and will remain a member of the Board in the future.

Prof. Dr Broy has been a member of the Witzenmann Supervisory Board since November 2021 and has been advising the family-owned company as a member of the Management Advisory Board since January 2019. Since 11 June 2024, he has been Chairman of the Witzenmann Supervisory Board.

As a renowned expert in the field of software and systems engineering, Prof. Dr Broy has published more than 520 scientific publications. His research focuses on the modelling and development of complex software-intensive systems. He examines practical questions of software development using mathematical and logical models. Additionally, he explores the role of software in a connected world, from its potential and impact to security issues.

Prof. Dr Broy is a member of the European Academy of Sciences, the Leopoldina, acatech and the Bavarian Academy of Sciences and Humanities. For his contributions, he has received numerous awards, including the Gottfried Wilhelm Leibniz Prize of the German Research Foundation (1994) and the Cross of the Order of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany (1996).



Prof. Dr Manfred Broy was born on 10 August 1949 in Landsberg am Lech. He is married and has three children. After studying mathematics with a minor in computer science at the Technical University of Munich (TUM), he obtained his doctorate in 1980 and completed his habilitation in 1982. In 1983, he was appointed full professor of computer science at the University of Passau and was the founding dean of the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science. In 1989, he returned to TUM as Chair of Computer Science, where he was appointed Founding Dean of the Department of Computer Science in 1992.

Furthermore, he is a co-founder and board member of the Centre for Digital Technology and Management (CDTM). The CDTM is a joint scientific institution of the Technical University of Munich and the LMU Munich and a member of the Elite Network of Bavaria.

From spring 2015 to spring 2019, he served as the founding president of the "Zentrum Digitalisierung. Bayern".
